Erasmus in Schools coordinator

Hereby the National Board launches the open call for the National Erasmus in Schools Coordinator 2017-2018 (as of 01/06/2017 up until 31/05/2018). Erasmus in Schools (EiS) is a relatively new project within SocialErasmus (SE) and it is important for the new coordinator to have a genuine enthusiasm for the project combined with the social skills to share this enthusiasm, and to have an eye for improvement combined with the proactive work attitude to implement changes if needed.

Task description

- Regular contact with local EiS coordinators to motivate them to organize their activities and to guide them.
- Regular contact with the responsible from EP-Nuffic (National Agency for internationalization) about the implementation and possible improvements of the project.
- Improve the execution of the project
- Increase the visibility of the project on the national level by using social media, the website and the Newsletter of ESN NL, in cooperation with fellow ESN NL volunteers.
- Enhance the sharing of knowledge and best practices of local EiS coordinators via different channels (Social Media, Wiki, Newsletter, Local SE Coordinators meeting, NPs)
- Cooperate with the National SE coordinator, National Board, the International SE Team and other National Coordinators.

Required Skills and Expertise

- Knowledge of and experience with SE/EiS (an understanding of the project, definition, goal and spirit) or a similar project.
- Communication skills
- Problem solving skills
- Good knowledge of written and spoken English

- Expand your network by working together with educational institutions, other organizations and local sections.
